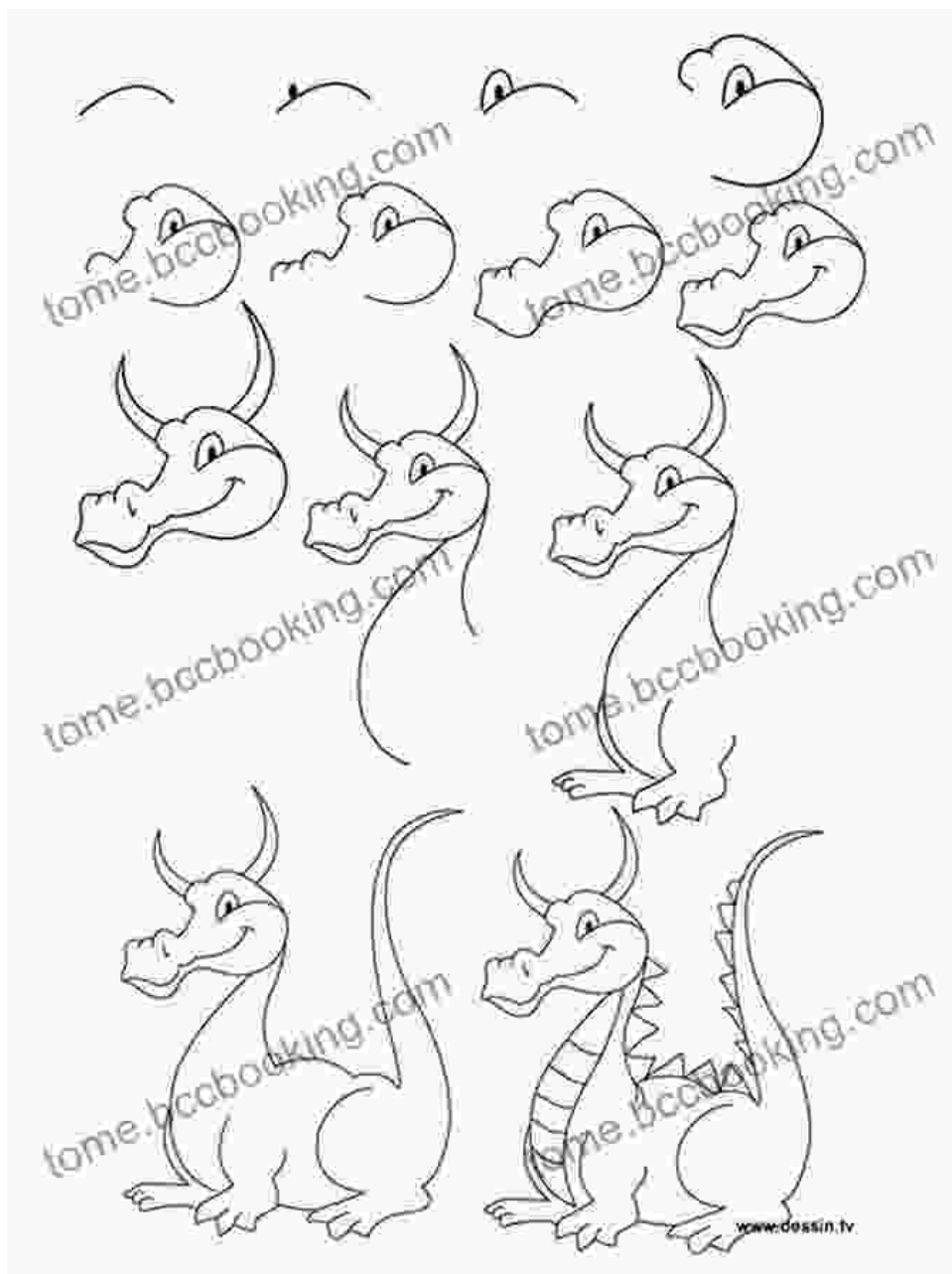

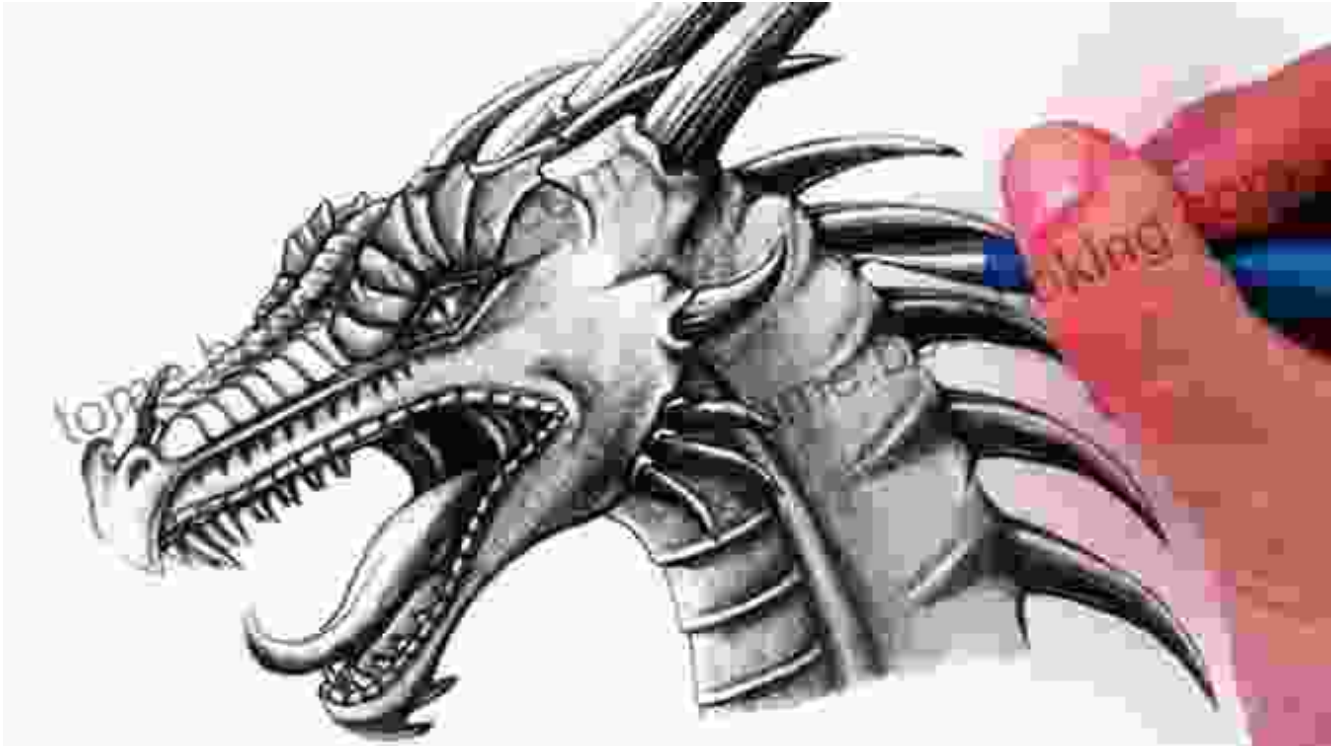

Start to indicate the ridges on the top of the muzzle and the folds on the front of the neck. Also try to define the overall direction of the muzzle. It's not just a simple line shape.



Work in the crests, which fall further back on the head since this is a 3/4 view, and the skin of the facial details. Use odd shaped shapes.

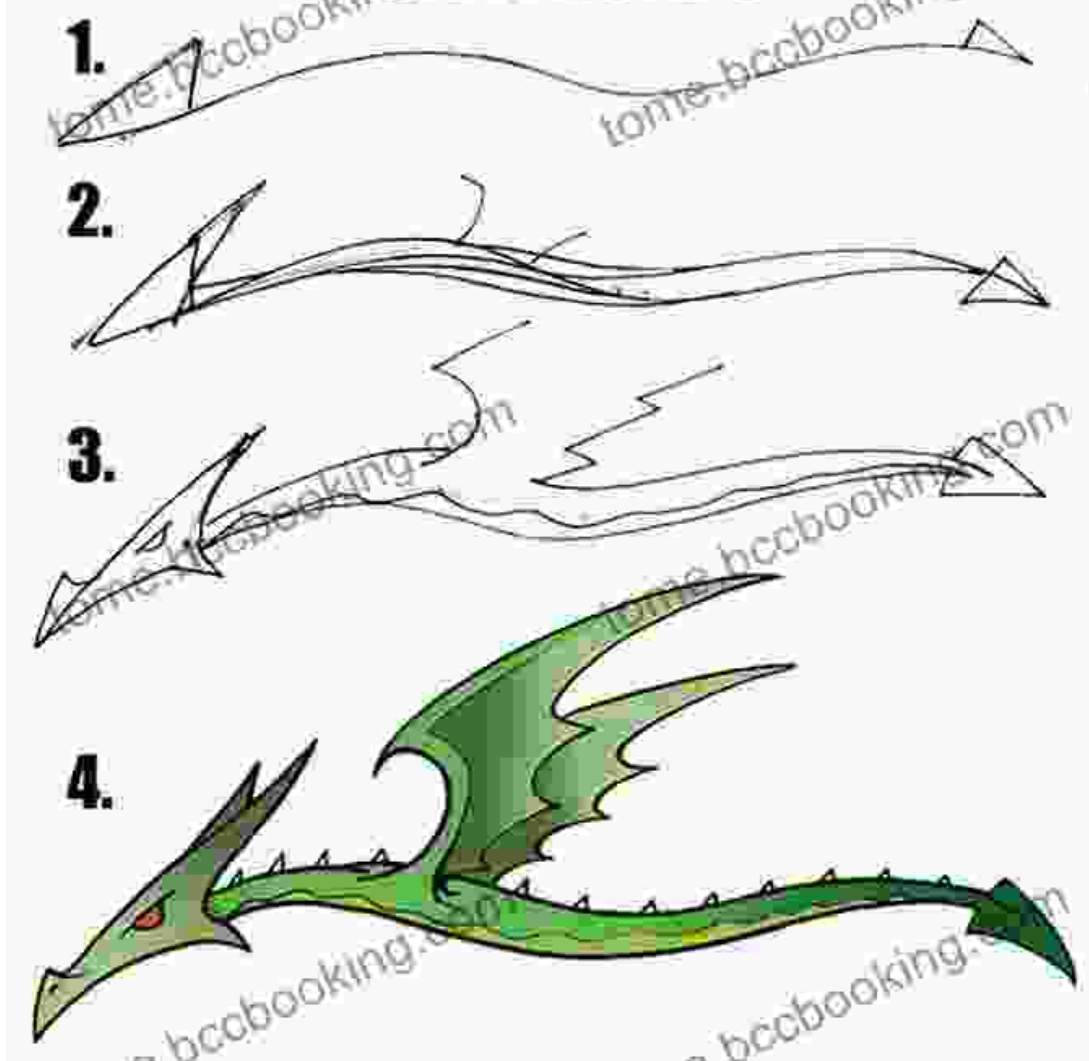


Develop the pattern of the horns and start to define the region that forms the front of the neck.

Start to indicate the ridges on the top of the muzzle and the folds on the front of the neck. Also try to show the overall direction of the muzzle. It's not just a simple line shape.



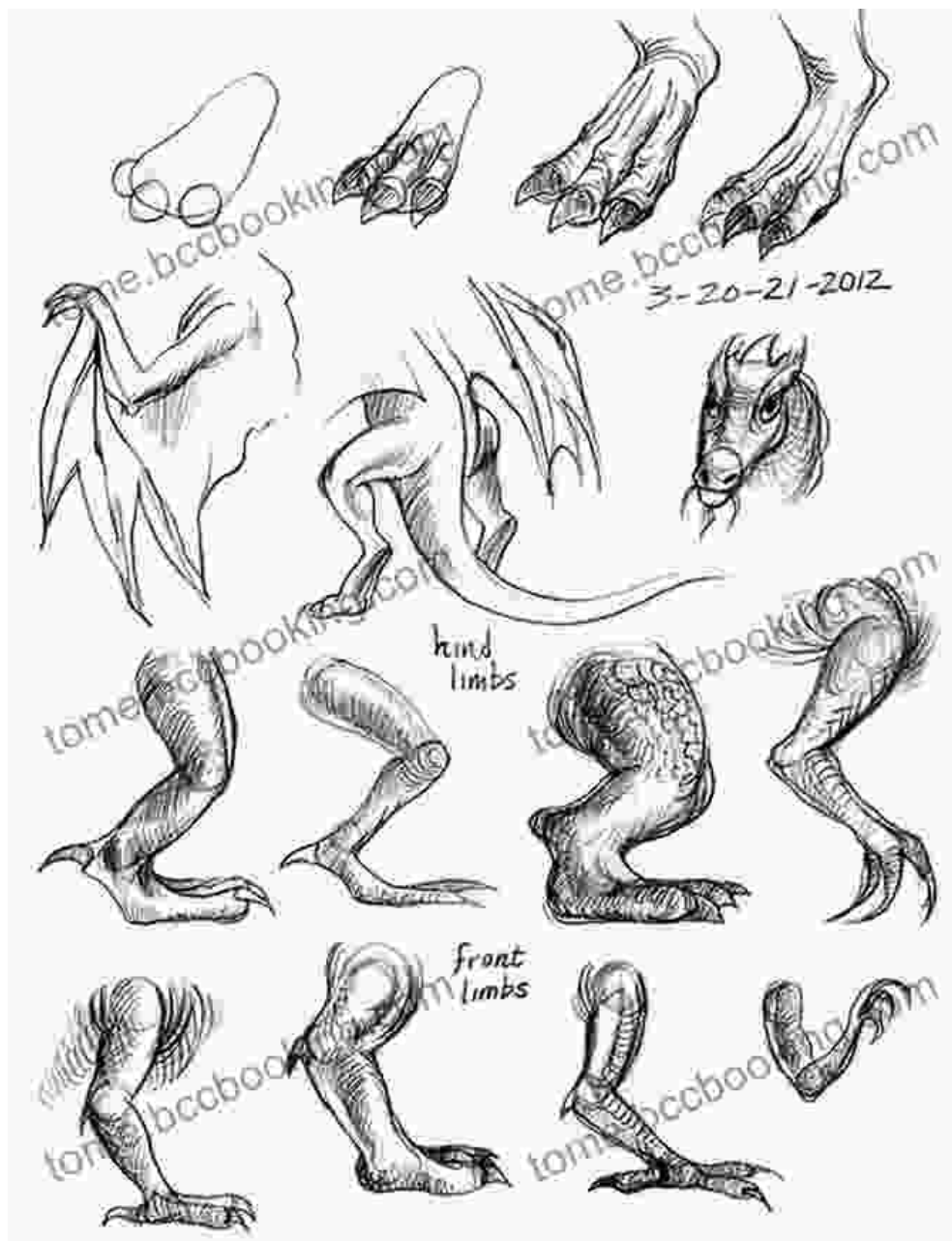
Work in the creasing, which falls further back on the head since this is a 3/4 view, and the skin of the facial details. Also add spiral fur pieces.



Develop the pattern of the horns and start to indicate the reptilian skin texture of the front of the neck.

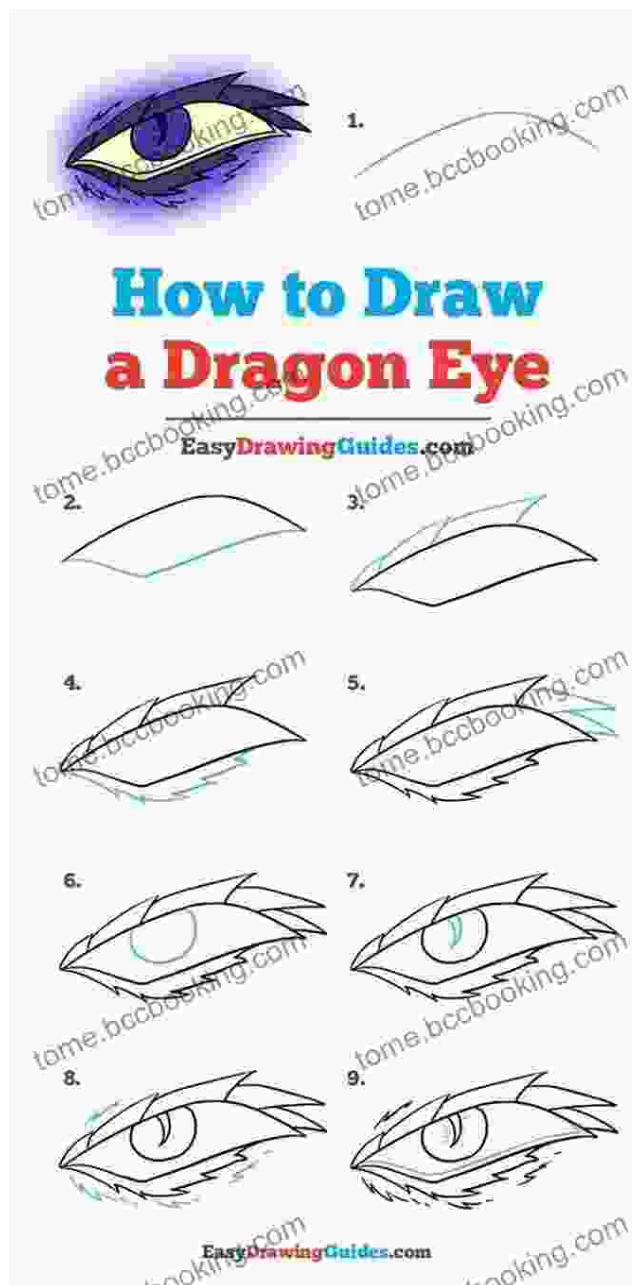

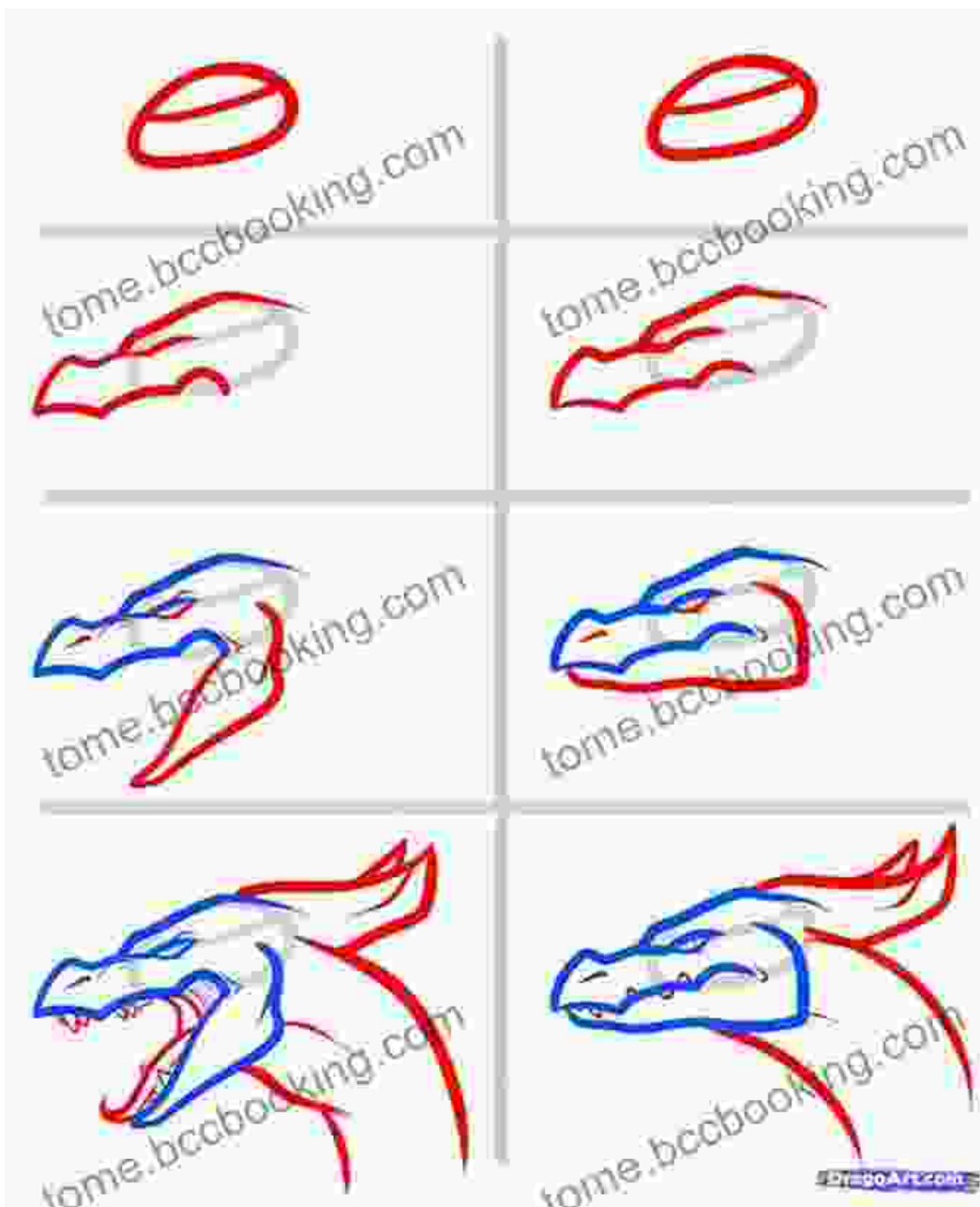

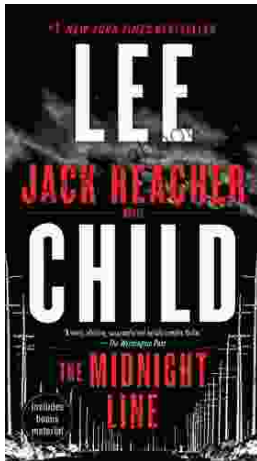
