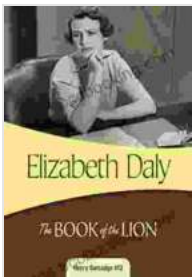


The Mystery of the Lion: A Henry Gamadge Mystery

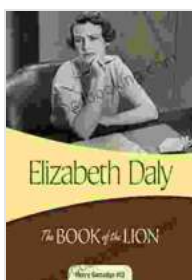
